## **BINGO example script:**

- ALT: Hello, my name is Matthew, it's nice to meet you.
- **JTE:** My name is \_\_\_\_\_, it's nice to meet you too.
- ALT: "Do you like eating hamburgers, \_\_\_\_\_?"
- JTE: Yes, thank you for asking.
- **ALT:** (respond with another sentence about the question) Me too, I love hamburgers with catsup.

OR, if the JTE's answer is no, say, "NO, I'm sorry."

(And then the ALT will write the JTE's name in the square and move on.)
