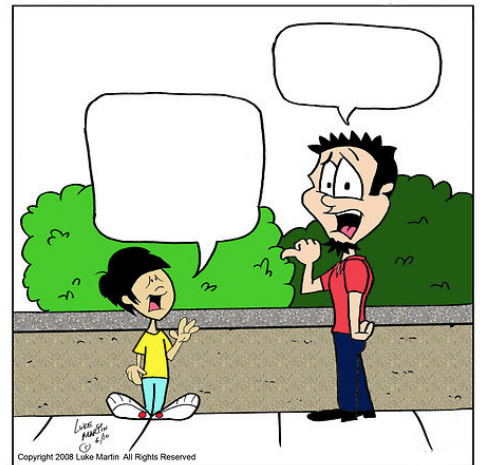

## Campus Interviews

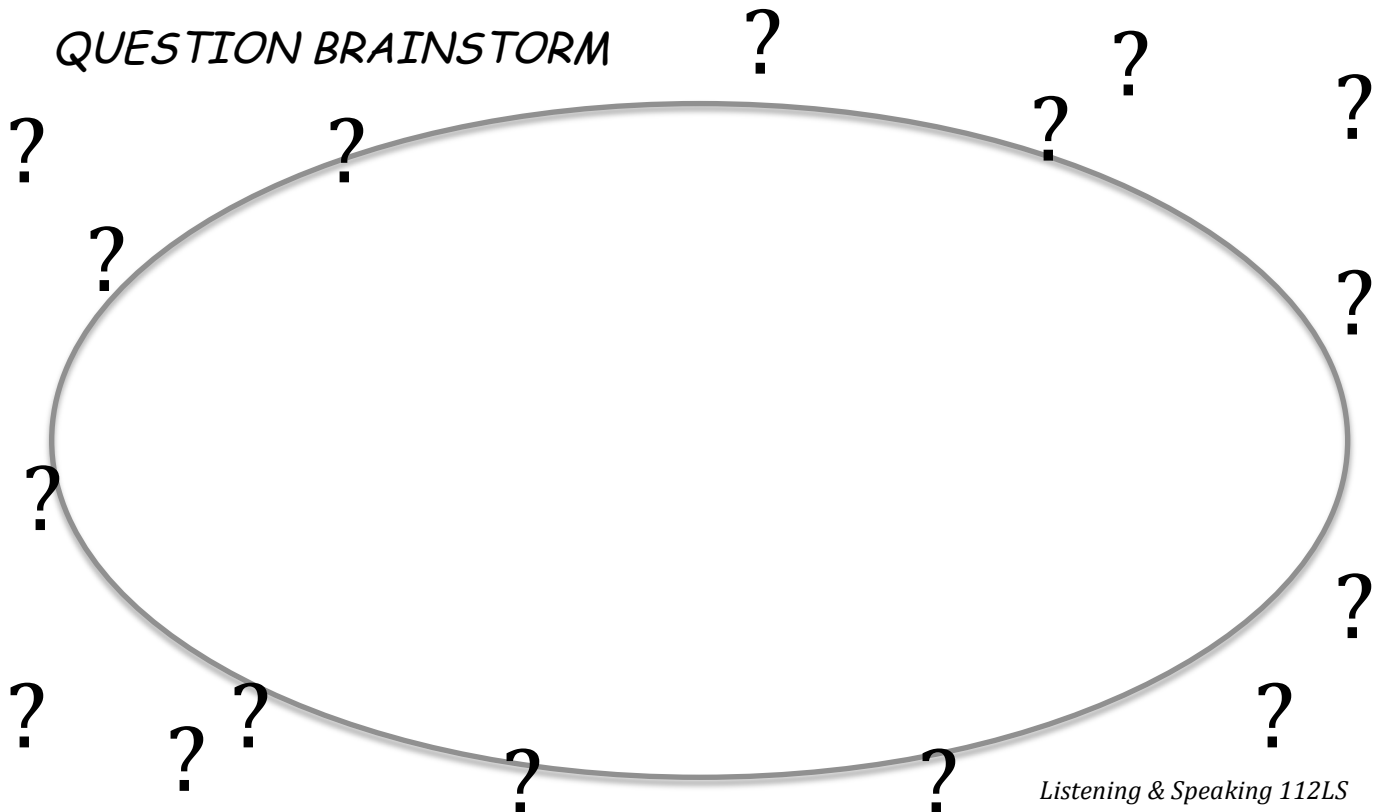
Interviews are helpful ways to practice basic conversation skills. In our class we will focus on 4 conversation skills: [initiation, continuation, questioning, and closing]

1. Initiation - *How can we start a conversation?*
2. Continuation - *How can we continue a conversation?*
3. Questioning - *How can we get more information?*
4. Closing - *How can we end a conversation?*

## Planning your Interview

*Make pairs. With you partner, please plan your interviews with college students.*

HINT: Excuse me. / Hello. How are you?  
Hello, my name is. . . / Hi, what's your name?

### GREETING

### INTRODUCTION

*We are international students at UH.*  
*We are interviewing UH students for our class.*  
*Do you mind answering a few questions?*

HINT: [Start simple.] Where are you from?  
Do you live in Hawaii?

### 1<sup>st</sup> QUESTION

HINT: [Follow-up question] Why did you come to Hawaii?  
How long have you lived here?

### 2<sup>nd</sup> QUESTION

**EXTRA QUESTIONS**

*HINT: Do you want to know more about what they talked about? Do you understand everything?*

**CLOSING**

*HINT: [Remember to signal and say thank you.]  
**Alright**, thanks. / **Well, ok**, thank you.*

**REMEMBER:**

- Eye Contact
- Use a big voice
- Speak slowly
