## Objectives:

The students will acquire practical English relating to being invited to an event. Key ideas: Communicating when, where, what time, etc.

| Task | Time | Procedure |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Warmup: Questions and Discussion | 5 | JTE or ALT will ask simple questions to get the students thinking in English. Students get a sticker if they are able to join in the discussion. |
| Part I: <br> Listening Comprehension | 5 | JTE and ALT will pass out the worksheet and read the following dialogue. The ALT will explain that this is a listening quiz and that there will be 4 follow-up questions. <br> Matt: Hey Kachan, how are you? <br> Kachan: Good, thanks. How are you, Matt? <br> Matt: Great! Did you hear about the party this weekend? You're invited. <br> Kachan: I haven't heard about it. When is it? <br> Matt: It's Saturday night at Live House. <br> Kachan: Really? That sounds great. <br> Matt: Yeah, a new band is performing. I think their name is Radwimps. Do you know them? <br> Kachan: Oh, sure, I really like their music. <br> Matt: Then let's go to the concert. Are you free this Saturday? <br> Kachan: Maybe. I have a part time job from 9 am to 3 in the afternoon. What time is the concert? <br> Matt: The doors open at 7:00, but it doesn't start until a quarter till 8. <br> Kachan: That's great! So, I can go. <br> Matt: Ok, let's go together. Where do you want to meet? <br> Kachan: Is the Ramen shop across from Hamakatsu ok? <br> Matt: Sure that sounds great. Let's meet at half past 6:00. <br> Kachan: No problem. I can't wait to go. <br> Matt: Me too. I'm really looking forward to going. See you there. |
| Listening Comprehension Quiz | 5 | JTE and ALT will give the students 2 minutes to look at their questions and try to answer them. After 2 minutes, the ALT will ask the questions out loud, while the students raise their hands to answer. <br> 1. Where is the concert? At live house <br> 2. What will Kachan do on Saturday morning? Part-time job <br> 3. What time will the concert begin? $\mathbf{7 : 3 0}$ <br> 4. What time will Matt and Kachan meet? $\mathbf{6 : 3 0}$ |


| Part II: Get the Info | 10 | The ALT will display the poster on the black board. The students will use the poster, which is also found on their handout, to answer the 6 questions. <br> 1. What is the date of the Party? August $26^{\text {th }}, 2006$ <br> 2. What time is the party over? $1: 00 \mathrm{pm}$ <br> 3. What day is the party? Saturday <br> 4. What should guests bring to the party? A giff for a baby <br> 5. Where will the party be? Amy Rainey's House <br> 6. What is a "baby shower"? A "baby shower" is a typical American party where guests bring a giff for the person being celebrated. This will lead to a discussion of American culture. (...to shower with gifts.) |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Pronunciation Practice | 5 | JTE and ALT will read the dialogue again, while the students repeat. If there is time, the students will make pairs and practice the dialogue again on their own. |
| Key Dialogue Practice | 5 | The JTE and ALT will read the key dialogue while the students repeat. Pairs of students will then be chosen to present the Key dialogue as time allows. |
| Part III: Activity | 10 | The students will plan an imaginary party, including: Where? When? What time? And What to bring? Once their party is planned, students will walk around the classroom inviting other students to their party. When a student is invited to a party, they must record the information on their paper. |
| Presentation | 5 | Students will present the information they gathered in the last activity. <br> Example presentation: <br> "Daisuke invited me to his party. It will be at Round One. His party will be on Friday night at 7:00. He asked me to bring some money and a camera. |
