## For the Survey Group Research

Project, you will be working together in groups of 3 or 4 . The purpose of this project is to use survey skills to gather data from other students or people in your community about a research topic that you are curious about. Your group will then present that information to the class using English and academic presentation skills.

2. Decide your research goals.
3. Plan your survey and questions.
4. Gather data using your survey questions. (25 per group member)
5. Discuss and graph/chart results.
6. Make a PowerPoint presentation.

a. On this slide, you should use some quotes or lists of information, how your participants feel and why. Qualitative data can only be expressed in words, not numbers.

b. Expectations: Did you expect the results that you got or where you surprised?
c. Suggestions: Do you have any suggestions based on your results?
